Regular Council Meeting Highlights

January 6, 2026

- Hinton Nordic Skiers announced they are holding their 50th Anniversary this winter.
- Mr. Jesse Mercier disputed responsibility for paying for a sanitary sewer repair at his home at 186 Sutherland Ave., Hinton.
- Council awarded Trans Mountain Town of Hinton bursaries to Ethan Braucht, Mavric Cortes, Cody Jones, and Gracey Kempin.
- Council gave Third Reading to the Borrowing Line of Credit to Finance Operating Expenditures Bylaw No. 2026.
- Council referred the Vehicle for Hire Bylaw No. 2024 to a Committee of the Whole Meeting prior to the end of January 2026.
- Council directed Administration to cover the costs of the sanitary sewer repair completed at 186 Sutherland Ave. minus the costs of auguring and steaming. The Sewer and Wastewater Bylaw No. 2006 will be discussed at a future Committee of the Whole Meeting.
