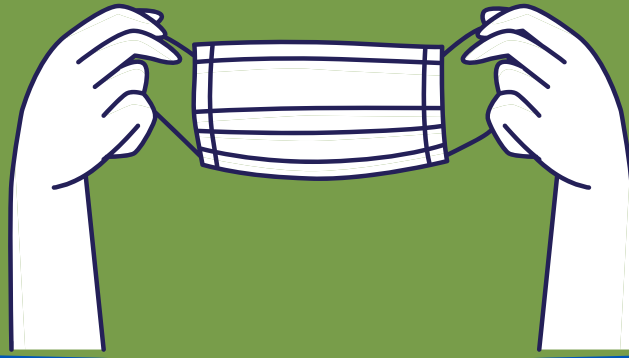


Masks are Mandatory for this Public Area in Hinton

While this action is not intended to be punitive, there are fines for refusing to wear a mask where prescribed to in the mask bylaw.

A person is guilty of an offence under this Bylaw if:

- They contravene the provisions of this Bylaw.
- They obstruct or hinder any person in the exercise or performance of the person's powers and duties under this Bylaw

Penalties: A person who is guilty of an offence is liable for a fine pursuant to Schedule "A" and issued in accordance with the MGA.

The fine schedule is:

Fail to wear a Face
Covering where required
Minimum: \$100
Specified Penalty: \$200.00

Interference with a person in the
exercise or performance of the person's
powers pursuant to
this bylaw
Minimum: \$250.00
Specified Penalty: \$500.00
