


23rd Annual Registration and Information Fair

40 KM/H Unless Otherwise Posted



The sign installation of the new 40 km/h speed limit signs is progressing. To help everyone adapt to the new speed limits, please assume a speed limit of 40 km/h unless otherwise posted. You may encounter a 40 km/h unless otherwise posted and promptly see a sign for 50 km/h following it. This occurs because the initial 40 km/h unless otherwise posted sign applies to the local residential streets in the area, while the subsequent 50 km/h sign applies to the neighbourhood collector road. Once you exit that collector road, assume 40 km/h unless otherwise posted.
