ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Town of Hinton is exploring development opportunities for the undeveloped, Town owned lands at the intersection of Boutin Ave and Drinnan Way. In order to best incorporate the visions and ideas of local stakeholders and the public, the Town is undertaking a design charrette to develop a site plan that seeks to determine the greatest and best use of the Town owned lands, and how they can be designed to meet the Town's current and future needs while being mindful of budgetary constraints.

WHAT IS A DESIGN CHARRETTE?

The Boutin Ave Design Charrette is an intensive engagement process that sees the project go from a vision stage to a final concept design over a four-day period. This dynamic process brings different stakeholder groups to the table to discuss their needs and vision for the site. The design team takes this information and creates a series of site plans that capture the different visions. After the four days, the intent is to have a preferred concept design that has the support from those who participated in the design charrette.

Over the course of four days, there will be ample opportunity to participate, however, it is requested that participants attend the events on three out of the four days to enable the project to reach its full potential.
