Permits & Bylaws

Road Closure

- ◆ If you are blocking your street to traffic you must apply for a (free) *Special Permit for Temporary Road Closure* from **Protective Services** (780-865-6009) at least two weeks in advance of NBP
- ◆ If you wish to place traffic barricades (after receiving road closure approval) contact **Public Works** (780-865-2634)
- ◆ Emergency vehicles may need access so place tables and chairs accordingly

Fire

- ◆ As per fire bylaw campfires must be in a contained firepit— contact **Protective Services** (780-865-6009) for firepit specifications
- ◆ Fireworks are not permitted

Other

- ◆ Alcohol consumption is illegal on Town roads and public property
- ◆ Excessively loud noise is prohibited any time— please keep noise level down

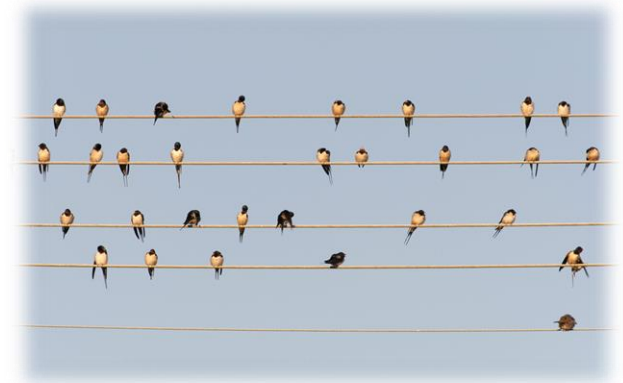

A **Neighbourhood Block Party (NBP)** creates an opportunity for neighbours (street, apartment building, cul-de-sac, etc.) to meet each other in a social environment and get to know one another better.

Neighbours who know one another tend to look out for each other and are aware of who belongs in the neighbourhood. This helps develop safe and more caring neighbourhoods.

To keep the NBP interactive we recommend keeping the maximum number of households invited to 25.
